

# Important Horse Project Changes for 2019:

- Horse paperwork must be submitted to Extension office by June 1. Penning assignments must be submitted by July 1. Each member & each horse must attend one of the following 4 events to exhibit at the fair.
  - Clinics May 18 at 9 a.m. for May 26 at 2 p.m.
  - PAŞ Shows June 15 at 9 a.m. of June 30 at 2 p.m.
- There will be no 2019 high point award.
- There is no limit on the number of PAŞ classes a member can enter; they do not have to be identified by June 1.
- Fair Schedule:
  - **NOTE: The schedule in the front of the fairbook is incorrect; correct show days are listed in the horse section.**
  - No required barn meeting on Sunday. A rules & reminder packet will be on each stall at check in. All horses must be in their stalls at 7 p.m. for body condition scoring by Horse Committee Vice President Pam Peebles.
  - Stall space is limited for the fair; each member should plan on stalling ONE animal at the fair. See Fairbook for details.
  - **Monday – Contest Show**
  - **Wednesday – Versatility Show**
    - **NOTE: Classes in the Fairbook are 2018 Classes; 2019 versatility classes will be drawn Wednesday morning.**
  - **Thursday – Pleasure Show**
  - **Friday – Fun Show**
  - See Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Show, page 8: All complaints must be taken to the show steward, Horse Committee President Jane Houin. Any complaint not resolved to your satisfaction with the steward must be accompanied by a \$100 non-refundable fee made out to the Holmes County 4-H Horse Committee the same day. No additional complaints will be accepted or considered.
