SFB Statement 6/11/2020

The Holmes County Senior Fair Board voted this evening to proceed with a nearly full fair schedule in light of the new, less restricted mandates released earlier in the week by the State.

This includes a full Jr. Fair under the original schedule prior to the Covid19 Pandemic. Amusement rides, food vendors and commercial vendors will also be included. The fair will host the open shows of Home Arts, Flowers and Photography. The board continues to work with the Holmes County Health Department for guidance and is committed to maintaining the in-place mandates, as well as recommended health practices to prevent the spread of the Covid19 virus.

A significant challenge is the ability to offer grandstand entertainment and meet the mandates of social distancing that exist. The board will be making a decision on grandstand entertainment in the very near future by weighing the limited number of spectators allowed as compared to the total cost of the events. The board wishes to thank the community in advance in making the Holmes County Fair the best it can be in 2020 under difficult circumstances. 


