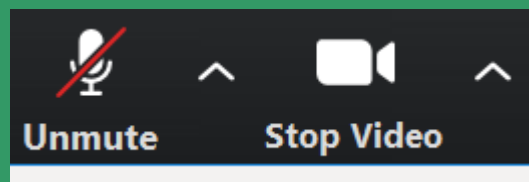
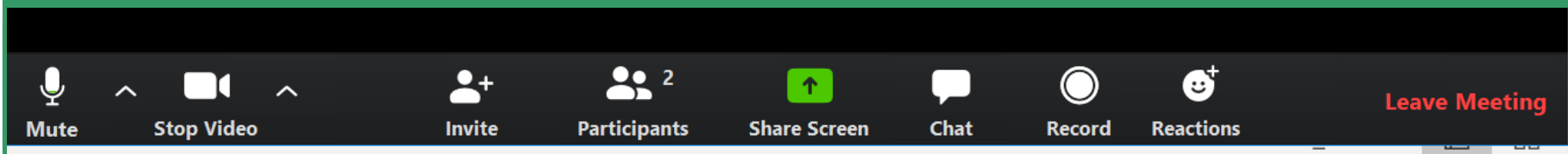

# ***SFB Statement 6/11/2020***

The Holmes County Senior Fair Board voted this evening to proceed with a nearly full fair schedule in light of the new, less restricted mandates released earlier in the week by the State.

This includes a full Jr. Fair under the original schedule prior to the Covid19 Pandemic. Amusement rides, food vendors and commercial vendors will also be included. The fair will host the open shows of Home Arts, Flowers and Photography. The board continues to work with the Holmes County Health Department for guidance and is committed to maintaining the in-place mandates, as well as recommended health practices to prevent the spread of the Covid19 virus.

A significant challenge is the ability to offer grandstand entertainment and meet the mandates of social distancing that exist. The board will be making a decision on grandstand entertainment in the very near future by weighing the limited number of spectators allowed as compared to the total cost of the events.

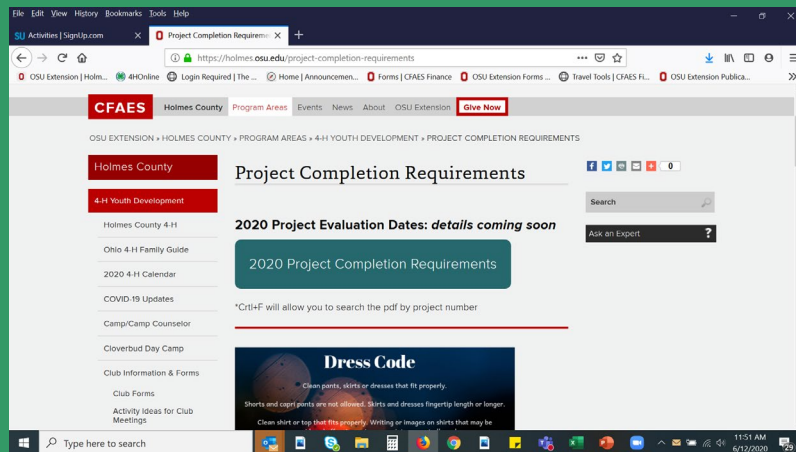

### MATERIALS NEEDED

#### 1. Kitchen Chemistry

(2 ) 1 Qt Ziplocks, (1) 1 Gal Ziplock, Half and Half, Whole Milk, Sugar, Vanilla, Spoon, Ice, Salt (ice cream salt if you have), Winter Gloves (you can also use orange juice)

#### 2. The Laundry Project

No materials needed. Just have access to your laundry room!

#### 3. Lets Start Cooking

Nonstick Cooking Spray, an Egg, Cookie Cutter or small rimmed bowl/jar, and a Slice of Bread (preferably whole wheat)

#### 4. Sew Much Fun

Needle, Thread of any color, Clothing Pins, Scissors, and Old Fabric

#### 5. It's My Home

(2) Empty Plastic Milk Jugs or Laundry Detergent Bottles, Scissors, Craft Tape or Duct Tape (try different colors!), Markers, and Scrap Paper

Milk jug, Scissors, String or Old Shoelace, Tape (colored if available), Choice of Stickers, Permanent Markers, or Paint
