

#### **Market Livestock Photo Notes:**

#### **List of things to DO:**

- \*Be sure you're taking a horizontal picture—if it's a phone turn it sideways
- \*Wash your animal
- \*Look nice-show clothes preferred
- \*Be Aware of what is in the background
- \*Exhibitor AND animal fully in the picture

#### **List of DON'Ts:**

- \*Don't take a vertical picture
- \*Don't crop the image –We'll do that if necessary
- \*Don't wear a hat or shorts
- \*Don't cut the animal out of view (if it moves during the picture, etc)

It's very possible that these pictures will be displayed on the big screen in the sale ring since we aren't bringing animals into the ring

for the sale. We want them to look GOOD!
