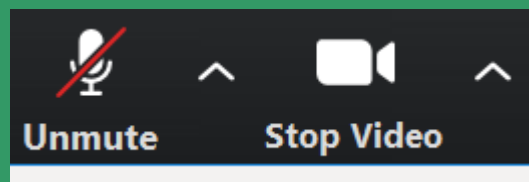
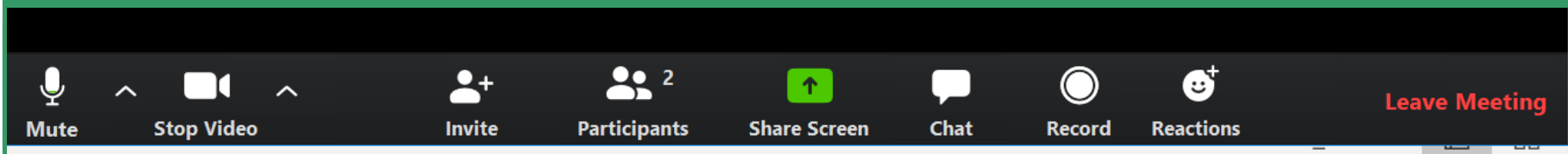

Public statement from the Holmes County Senior Fair Board, May 14, 2020:

No decisions regarding changes to the 2020 fair have been officially made as of this date, but there is no doubt the fair will look significantly different this year. During this unprecedented time, the Holmes County Senior Fair Board is working behind the scenes concerning possible changes to the fair schedule. The board is preparing contingency plans for various scenarios that we may have to work through once a determination is made concerning the type of fair that we can host, including virtual scenarios. We are in constant communication with the Ohio Department of Agriculture, and the Ohio Fair Managers Association as we await guidance and mandates for Ohio fairs. The goal must be to assure best practices for the safety of our participants, exhibitors, volunteers, staff and attendees. Be assured that the board will work tirelessly to host the best fair that we can under directives and financial constraints that we are facing, no matter how limited or different than normal this may be. Supporting our youth who are already working hard with their various 4H and FFA projects is foremost. To the best of our ability, we will work to support our vendors, many whose livelihoods come from the fair and festival industry. Thank you for your patience and understanding as the board tackles many difficult decisions in the coming days. Updates will be released as soon as possible.
