

#### Public statement from the Holmes County Senior Fair Board, May 14, 2020:

No decisions regarding changes to the 2020 fair have been officially made as of this date, but there is no doubt the fair will look significantly different this year. During this unprecedented time, the Holmes County Senior Fair Board is working behind the scenes concerning possible changes to the fair schedule. The board is preparing contingency plans for various scenarios that we may have to work through once a determination is made concerning the type of fair that we can host, including virtual scenarios. We are in constant communication with the Ohio Department of Agriculture, and the Ohio Fair Managers Association as we await guidance and mandates for Ohio fairs. The goal must be to assure best practices for the safety of our participants, exhibitors, volunteers, staff and attendees. 
