- Attend Project Evaluation (either Livestock Project Evaluation & Skill-a-thon or a Pre-Evaluation).

  - Follow and complete all sections of the Member Project Guide.
  - o Complete one or more Topics of Interest.

  - Complete two Leadership and Citizenship Activities.
- Read and study the Sheep Resource Handbook for Market and Breeding Projects (#194R).
- Book should be neat and accurate. Attitude and appearance will also be evaluated (please refer to 4-H Evaluations Dress Code).

- Papers and receipts should be in order and included in Record Book from year to year
