# **Horse Project Skillathon Study Guide**

Members are required to bring a completed record book **and** project book for each project animal. For the Beginning Horse Management project only, the record book is located at the back of your project book; members with this project do not need a separate equine record book. All other members must bring both their project book and equine record book to project evaluation. If you have registered a back up animal, you must include records for that animal as well to maintain that animal's backup eligibility. There is space for 2 animals to be included in the equine record book.
