## DUNF

- DUNFs will be completed ONLINE again this year.
- **The link is now open, and the form can be found at: [go.osu.edu/hc\\_dunf24](https://go.osu.edu/hc_dunf24)**
- All Species but Poultry may complete their DUNF ahead of check-in except POULTRY. They will complete their DUNF at check-in when they get their wing band/identification.
- A parent must be present at POULTRY check-in to sign and complete the DUNF form. All other species do not need a parent present at check-in.
- Please complete and submit a separate DUNF for each market and or lactating animal(s) being brought to the fair. Be sure to have proof ready to show at check-in if need be.
- You will be asked to submit a new DUNF as needed or directed by the Fair Vet if needed during the fair.

## TACK SET UP

- Please do NOT move your tack in until Friday, August 2, 2024. Tack areas have been designated for specific species in different areas near the livestock barn.
- If you have specific questions about tack, please reach out to a Livestock Committee member.

## STALL CARDS

- All livestock exhibits must display a completed Member/Animal Identification card provided by the Holmes County Fair.
- These must be in place by 8pm Sunday, August 4.
- Cards can be picked up in the SFB office.

## PRE-FAIR OFFICE HOURS AUGUST 2-4 10AM – 7PM

## GOLF CARTS

- Golf carts/UTV's may not be driven on the drive surrounding the midway area.
- You must provide proof of insurance, pay \$40 permit fee, & keep permit issued on golf cart/UTV throughout the week.
- Golf carts/UTV's may not be left randomly around the grounds. Please park in designated golf cart areas near tack tent or in your camper space.
- Only carry the number of riders that can sit on a seat.
- Drivers must be 16 years of age and older – be prepared to show a driver's license/ID card if requested by a Fair Board member or Harvest Ridge Staff.
- If any of the above rules are ignored, you may be asked to immediately remove your golf cart/UTV.
